Employer's responsibility:

Duty of care

Options of health insurance coverage while on assignment

Only local coverage in the assignment country

- Employee will terminate his current health insurance
- Only taking out a local health insurance in the country of destination

Local health insurance plus international coverage

- Every employee is taking out the international coverage in addition to the plan he/she had in their home country
- Different health insurance coverage and premiums

International plan

 Every employee on assignment or working abroad has the same medical coverage.

Recommendation

- Whenever possible trying to have an equal treatment
- Less administration
- Checking on options of health insurance coverage when returning
